

Payment Information for Summer Semester 2017

Summer Semester begins May 8, 2017.

All students must pay in full (or make payment arrangements) by noon on May 2.

Otherwise, classes may be dropped. You must drop if you decide not to attend.

Class Participation: Students who do not attend class will lose financial aid eligibility. Class participation is required to remain eligible for financial aid programs. No-show students will lose financial aid funds. The student will then be responsible for paying balances due to TSTC.

Financial aid credit balance refunds will be transmitted to the BankMobile TechOne Card after 7 p.m. on May 22. No early payments. Visit www.techonecard.com for details. Credit balances will be released if the student is eligible based on enrollment, class participation, SAP and if other eligibility criteria is met.

To avoid any tuition charges, review your schedule and make necessary changes prior to the first class day of the semester. Refunds will be calculated for schedule changes made on or after the first day of the semester. The student is responsible for making schedule changes, dropping classes, or withdrawing at the Office of Admissions.

Payment Plan

- **First Payment**
First payment is 34 percent of the total tuition plus a \$25 non-refundable fee.
- **15-week Session**
Payment #2 due June 7; payment #3 is due July 12
- **12-week Session**
Payment #2 is due June 1; payment #3 is due June 29.
- **\$25 late fee**
A \$25 late fee is assessed for each missed payment deadline.

All campuses except Williamson County: Once your registration is complete, enroll online through WebAdvisor (Financial Information/TouchNet Payment Plans). The Advisement Center and Student Accounting (Building EK) can assist. See the Cashier only if paying cash for your down payment.

Williamson County: See Cashier to make your first payment and complete your contract.

Emergency Tuition Loan

Limited funds are available. See Financial Aid staff to start the process and sign your contract.

Requirements:

1. Students must apply first for financial aid at the financial aid office or www.fafsa.gov, and have completed all financial paperwork.
2. Be in good academic standing (cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher).
3. Be enrolled for at least six credit hours.
4. Have no delinquent loans or account balances with TSTC.
5. Must not be on financial aid suspension

Other Information

- Emergency tuition loans are for tuition only (books, insurance, dorms, meals, etc. are not covered).
- Students must notify the Student Accounting Department when withdrawing from TSTC.
- Withdrawing or dropping a course does not void the obligation for repayment of the tuition loan, payment plan, or any other debt.
- Student can have either a payment plan or an emergency loan, but not both.
- Emergency loan payment due in full on June 8, 2017.

Parking Permits are available at no cost with Campus Police in Building A. Remember to bring your driver's license, Registration Statement, and vehicle information (license plate, year, model, etc.).
