<u>Individual Assistance may include:</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Temporary Housing ● Lodging Expenses Reimbursement ● Homeowner Repair ● Home Replacement ● Permanent or Semi-Permanent Housing Construction ● Disaster-caused child care expenses ● Disaster-caused medical and dental expenses ● Disaster-caused funeral and burial expenses ● Disaster-caused damages to essential household items (room furnishings, appliances); clothing; tools (specialized or protective clothing and equipment) required for your job; necessary educational materials (computers, school books, supplies) ● Fuel for the primary heat source (heating oil, gas) ● Clean-up items (wet/dry vacuum, dehumidifier) ● Disaster-caused damage to an essential vehicle ● Moving and storage expenses caused by the disaster (moving and storage of personal property while repairs are being made to the primary residence, and returning property to the primary address). ● Other necessary expenses or serious needs as determined by FEMA. ● Other expenses that are authorized by law ● Transitional Shelter Assistance

Customers living in the affected counties are encouraged to bring whatever identity and residency documentation they have in their possession
