



## **HESI A & P: Anatomy and Physiology Exam**

This **HESI A&P** exam evaluates a student's understanding of the structure and function of the human body. Questions may cover topics such as the skeletal, muscular, cardiovascular, respiratory, nervous, digestive, urinary, and reproductive systems. It tests knowledge of organ systems, anatomical terminology, physiological processes, and how they relate to health and illness.

The fee for the exam is \$47 plus tax, payable on the exam day. Students will also be responsible for the proctoring fee of \$25 plus a \$7 one-time annual registration fee.

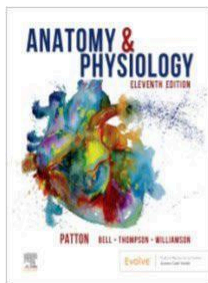

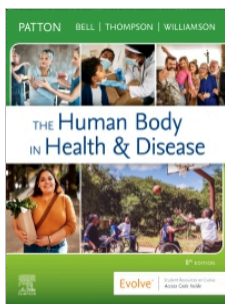
