The Bill established requirements applicable to contracts with a value in excess of \$1 million. This included the requirement that the TSTC Board of Regents must approve and sign contracts with a value greater than one million dollars. Senate Bill 20 has a provision for the Governing Board to delegate to the Chancellor or his

Designee this authority.

Justification: Texas State Technical enters into electric energy purchase contracts that

> exceed \$1,000,000. Due to the fluctuation of pricing in the electrical market it is prudent to delegate the authority, to approve and sign these contracts timely, to the Chancellor or Designee to take advantage of the market movement and

the most advantageous pricing.

#### Dear Chancellor Reeser:

As requested, I have considered the legal ramifications of the delegation of authority from the Board of Regents to the Chancellor or his designee to enter into and sign contracts in excess of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) for the purchase of goods or services.

During the 84<sup>th</sup> Legislative Session comprehensive changes were made to the Government Code. Generally the TSTC Board of Regents alone has authority to approve and sign contracts with a value of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) or greater. However, among the changes made to the Government Code is a provision that allows the TSTC Board of Regents to delegate this authority to the Chancellor or his designee.

TSTC enters into electric energy purchase contracts that exceed One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00). In order to take advantage of pricing fluctuations in the electrical market it would be prudent to delegate authority to sign these contracts to the Chancellor or his designee to ensure the most advantageous pricing possible for TSTC.

Having reviewed the changes to the Government Code, after the passage of Senate Bill 20 during the 84<sup>th</sup> Legislative Session, it is my opinion that the delegation of authority from the Board of Regents to the Chancellor or his designee to enter into and sign contracts in excess of One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) for the purchase of goods or services comports with state law and TSTC policy, and that this delegation is in the best interest of TSTC students as well as the State of Texas.

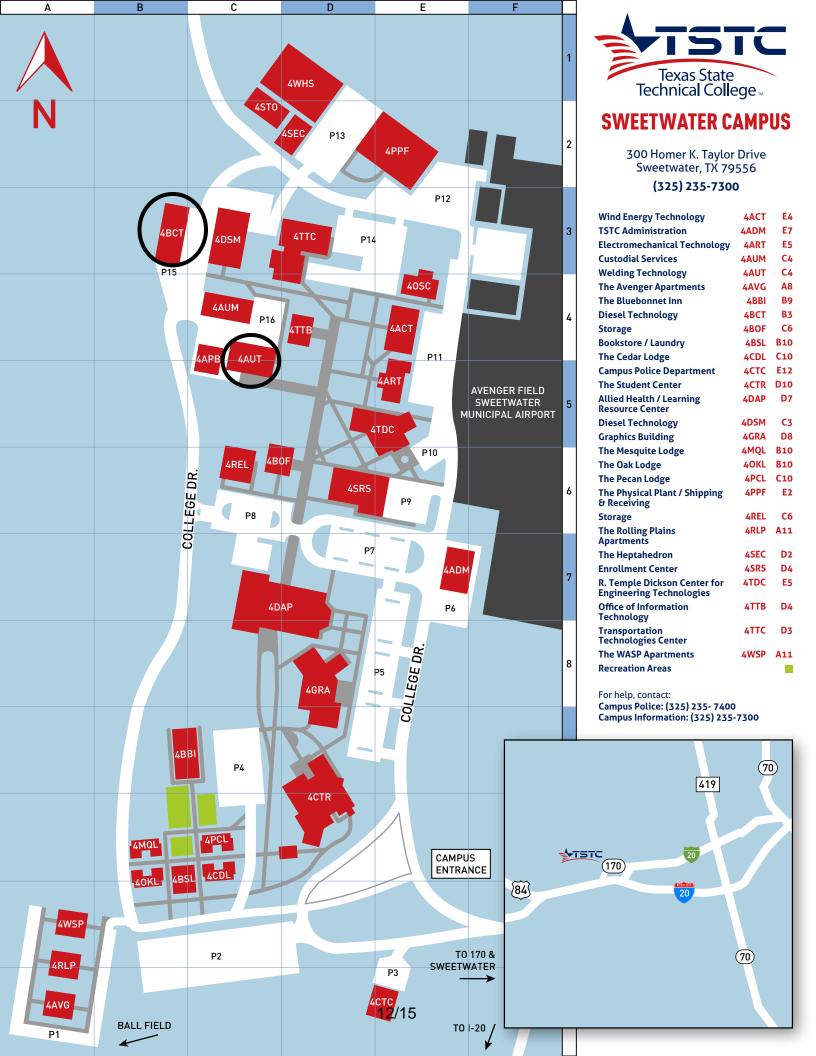
