Subject: Approve Operating Budget for Fiscal Year 2023

Background: The TSTC administration proposes a Fiscal Year 2023 operating budget of

\$258,398,719. The sources of funds for the proposed budget include anticipated operating revenues of \$253,489,221 and use of historical reserves of \$4,909,498.

Justification: The proposed Fiscal Year 2023 budget supports TSTC's future growth plans and

related transformational initiatives. TSTC estimates an increase in Fiscal Year 2023 revenues, primarily due to higher levels of tuition revenue, driven by enrollment growth. The increase in budgeted expenditures for Fiscal Year 2023 relates to increased spending on teaching and learning capacity, employee development and compensation, scheduled maintenance and other improvements, as well as

increases for inflation.

AdditionalThe proposed budgets for Educational and General (E&G) funds are in balance with legislative appropriations, projected tuition, and other appropriated income. The

legislative appropriations, projected tuition, and other appropriated income. The proposed budgets for Designated, Auxiliary, and Plant Funds are based on estimates that are supported by anticipated and historical activities. The proposed budgets for Restricted Funds are limited to those funds available from existing grants and contracts. Historically, these budgets increase during the year as new agreements are approved; these increases often result in additional FTEs. Total

budgeted FTEs from all fund sources for Fiscal Year 2023 total 1,543.

Fiscal Implications: Authorizes TSTC operating budgets for Fiscal Year 2023.
