At TSTC, college housing is an added service for the convenience of students who need economical housing. The apartment-style housing is conveniently located within walking distance of classrooms, labs, recreational facilities and the TSTC Café. Occupancy of college housing is granted on a first-come, first-served basis without regard to the individual's race, color, gender, religion, national origin, age, disability, genetic information or veteran status. Please note: New housing residents must have received the bacterial meningitis vaccine a minimum of 10 days prior to moving in.

Available Housing:

Single Students:

Oak Tree Apartments: Up to four students. Double Occupancy: Two students/bedroom. Single Occupancy: One student/bedroom.

Palo Blanco Dorms: Up to two students with kitchenette. Single Occupancy: One student/residence.

Las Palmas Dorms: Up to two students with microwave and refrigerator. Single Occupancy: One student/residence.

Cost Per Student: Oak Tree Apartments: Per Semester Double Occupancy: \$830 Single: \$1,265

Single Occupancy: Per Semester Palo Blanco/Las Palms Dorms: Double Occupancy: \$900 Single Occupancy: \$1,385

*Single students must be registered for a minimum of three credit hours per semester.

Families* (Married/Single Parents):

Two Bedrooms: \$778 per month. Maximum occupancy of four persons.

*In family housing, at least one member of the household must be a full-time student with six or more credit hours.

How to Apply:

- Submit this College Housing Application as soon as possible, preferably at least one semester before you plan to attend TSTC.
- Enclose a \$200 deposit (per student) when you submit this application. Your deposit should be a personal check, certified check, credit card or money order.
- Please write your permanent (home) address on all checks. Family housing residents are not required to pay the deposit until move-in date.
- Include a \$30 non-refundable application fee with your deposit and the release of background information sheet.
- Prior to enrollment, you will be notified by the housing office of your acceptance into college housing and your room assignment. If housing is not available, you will be so notified and contacted again if a vacancy becomes available.
- Rent for single student housing is due in full at registration.
- The first rent payment for family housing is due at registration. Rent is then due on the first of each month thereafter.
- All single campus housing apartments are furnished and rent includes utilities. You must provide your own linens, cooking utensils and personal items.
