Program Requirements

- Must be admitted to TSTC and meet all college admission requirements.
- Attend a mandatory VN Information Session.
- Test and reach benchmark scores for ATI TEAS® version 7 as follows: Reading, Math and English Language minimum score: 50. Science minimum score: 40.
- Complete online application for the VN Program. Link will be provided after attending the information session.

Complete all prerequisite courses:

- Prerequisite courses must be completed within the last 5 years. Minimum grade of "C" in A&P I & II, and for Medical Terminology.
- BIOL 2401 A&P I (or BIOL 2301 & 2101)
- BIOL 2402 A&P II (or BIOL 2302 & 2102)
- HPRS 2302 Medical Terminology for Allied Health

Copies of valid identification documents required:

- Driver's license or state issued ID.
- Social Security card.
- Signed Letters of Recommendations (3).
- CPR card from American Heart Association–BLS Healthcare Provider ONLY.
- Proof of personal health insurance.
- Copy of unofficial transcripts.
- Copy of ATI TEAS Version 7 Scores.

Up-to-date immunizations (copies of documents must be signed/stamped by a physician or office).

- COVID vaccine (Exemption form or proof of vaccine may be required by clinical industry partners)
- Meningitis (if younger than 22 years old)
- Tuberculosis (within 1 year or x-ray within 5 years)
- DPT (booster within 10 years)
- Varicella (or titer)
- Hepatitis B x3
- Flu vaccine
- MMR
