Class Participation: Students who do not attend class will lose financial aid eligibility. Class participation is required to remain eligible for financial aid programs. No-show students will lose financial aid funds. The student will then be responsible for paying balances due to TSTC.

To avoid any tuition charges, review your schedule and make necessary changes prior to the first-class day of the semester. Refunds will be calculated for schedule changes made on or after the first day of the semester. The student is responsible for making schedule changes, dropping classes or withdrawing at the Enrollment Center.

\$25 late fee After a 7-day grace period, a \$25 late fee is assessed for each missed payment deadline.

Emergency Tuition and Book Loans

Limited funds are available. See Student Accounting staff to sign your contract.

Requirements:

- Students must apply first for financial aid at the Enrollment Center or <u>www.fafsa.gov</u>, and have completed all financial paperwork.
- 2. Be in good academic standing (cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher).
- Be enrolled for at least six credit hours.
- Have no delinquent loans or account balances with TSTC.
- 5. Must not be on financial aid suspension

Other Information

- Emergency loans are available for tuition and book expenses only. Costs such as insurance, dorms, meals, etc., are not covered.
- Students must notify the Student Accounting Department when withdrawing from TSTC.
- Withdrawing or dropping a course does not cancel your obligation to repay an emergency tuition or book loan, payment plan, or any other outstanding debt.
- Student can have either a payment plan or an emergency loan, but not both.
- Emergency loans for tuition and books are due in full on the following dates:

How to get your STUDENT ID CARD

All college-credit students are required to obtain TSTC identification (ID) cards when they register.

Steps to upload your photo online:

- 1. Go to http://csgold-web.tstc.edu/ and log in with your TSTC OneID username and password.
- 2. Click on "Submit ID Photo"—located on the right side of the screen under MENU.
- 3. Upload a photo of yourself. (Head, shoulder and face clearly visible and facing forward)
- 4. Click "Submit" to have your photo reviewed

Once your photo is approved and you receive emails from BankMobile, you should receive your Student ID Card in the mail about two weeks later. Your card will arrive in a **GREEN** envelope, simply follow these steps to make your refund preference selection:

1. Visit refundselection.com 2. Enter your personal code 3. Select how you want your money delivered
