

REQUIREMENTS FOR EMS PROGRAMS

Application Requirements

All EMS Programs:

- Attend information session
- Apply to TSTC

Copies of valid identification documents required:

- Driver's license
- CPR card from BLS Healthcare Provider - American Heart Association
- Proof of personal health insurance.
- Background Check
- Drug Screen
- Physical

Copies of Up-to-date immunizations*:

- Hepatitis B Vaccine Series (3 shots, takes 6 months to complete or only one month if taking HEPLISAV-B vaccine.)
- Current Tuberculosis (TB) Test (current within one year)
- Bacterial Meningitis (not required if over 22 years of age)
- TDAP-Tetanus-Diphtheria & Pertussis. Expires every 10 years.
No Tetanus only.
- Varicella or Exposure Verification (form will be provided as an attachment)
- Measles, Mumps, and Rubella Vaccines (MMR)
- Flu Shot (Only needed for Fall & Spring classes)

*Other vaccines may be required by clinical or practicum facilities. These may include COVID and yearly flu. Students should work with their campus Program Team Lead if an exemption is needed; however, TSTC cannot guarantee that an exemption will be granted by a third-party facility partner.

Paramedic Program Requirements:

- EMT License (if applying for Paramedic Program)
- Paramedic Application
- Letters of Reference
- Entrance Exam
- Interview
- Information Session
- Letter of Intent
