



ATI TEAS Admission Exam--HARLINGEN

The **ATI TEAS (Test of Essential Academic Skills)** is designed to specifically assess a students' academic preparedness prior to entering the [Vocational Nursing Program](#).

- **Scores are good for two years from the date of testing.**

The ATI TEAS measures basic skills in the academic areas of reading, mathematics, science and English & language usage. Scores will be reviewed and points will be awarded based on each area's score as well as the overall score.

The time limit for the exam is approximately **4 hours** and will consist of **170 questions**.

 - Check the box to acknowledge that you have read and understand the testing center policies
- Click add to cart
- Click complete registration
- Click continue
- Complete the credit card fields and continue (a confirmation email will be sent)

Testing Fees & Requirements

Before exam day

- The ATI TEAS Exam requires that you create an account at the following link: www.atitesting.com

You will create a username and a password which you will use to launch your exam on your scheduled test date.

Testing Fees:

- **On campus fees: \$107 (total)**
 - \$7 annual registration fee charged by Register Blast (3rd party scheduling system)
 - \$25 TSTC testing center proctoring fee (if testing **on campus**)
 - \$70 +tax (ATI Exam fee)

Testing Fees:

- Virtual fees: \$120 (paid directly to ATI)

Exam fee will be paid on the day of testing with a credit or debit card.
