



## PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Must be admitted to TSTC and meet all college admission requirements
- Attend a **mandatory** VN Information Session

Take the ATI TEAS® version 7 pre-entrance exam

- Points will be awarded based on overall and sub-section scores
- The ATI TEAS exam may be taken 2 times per application period
- Scores are valid for 24 months

Complete online application for the VN Program. Link will be provided after attending the MANDATORY information session.

### Complete all prerequisite courses:

- A&P 1 and 2 courses must be completed within the last 5 years
- Minimum grade of "C" in A&P I & II and Medical Terminology
- BIOL 2401 A&P I (or BIOL 2301 & 2101) or equivalent
- BIOL 2402 A&P II (or BIOL 2302 & 2102) or equivalent
- HPRS 2302 Medical Terminology for Allied Health or equivalent

### Copies of valid identification documents required:

- Driver's license or state issued ID
- Social Security card
- Signed Letters of Recommendation (3)
- CPR card from American Heart Association–BLS Healthcare Provider ONLY
- Proof of personal health insurance
- Copy of unofficial transcripts
- Copy of ATI TEAS version 7 scores

### Up-To-Date Immunizations

(Copies of documents must be signed/stamped by a physician or office)

- Meningitis (if younger than age 22)
- Tuberculosis (within one year or x-ray within five years)
  - Students with QuantiFERON-TB gold results must complete a TB exposure prior to admission and on a yearly basis, or at the clinical facility's request
- DPT (booster within 10 years)
- Varicella (or titer)
- Hepatitis B x3
- Flu vaccine
- MMR (or titer)
- Other vaccines may be required by clinical or practicum facilities. These may include COVID and yearly flu. Students should work with their campus Program Team Lead if an exemption is needed; however, TSTC cannot guarantee that an exemption will be granted by a third-party facility partner.
